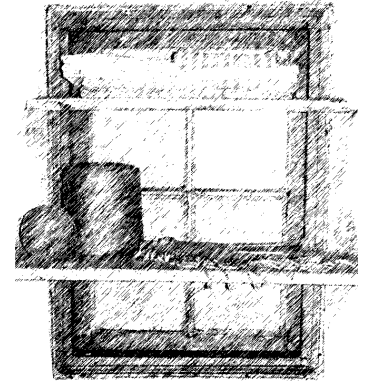
WELCOME to Museum 'Het Leids Wevershuis' (The Leiden Weaver House). This authentic Weaver House was built about 1560, in the heyday of the Leiden textile industry. Many features from the 16th and 17th centuries have been preserved.

The interior of the Weaver House takes the visitor back into the 19th century, into the living condition of ordinary people. The front room recreates the workplace of the home weavers. In the corridor, a mural lists the names of the residents (weavers and others) from 1561.

During opening hours, the antique loom (1830) is nearly always in operation. Exhibitions are held in summer and lectures in winter.

The shop offers a small collection of handmade products for sale.
